Issues and Changes

Saving/Loading

- Pages are loaded in the top to bottom in the save file
- Previously Pages were saved in alphabetical order, but the page name and tab name aren't the same
- Pages are now saved and loaded in according the order seen in line 2 of the save file

Manual Ordering

- Added a window to select the order of page
- Then order the pageList variable in the desired order
- Then the order is saved and then we reload the save file

Alphabetical Ordering

- Grab the tab name from the each object in the pageList
- The tab and page names are stored in a 2d array
- Then the array is sorted alphabetically by tab name and then the page names are saved in that order
- Then we save the list to the file and then load it

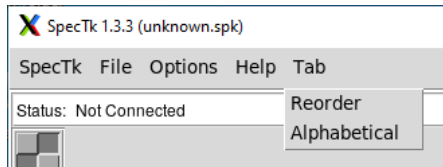
How to Use

Install/Setup

- Version 1.3.3 can be found [Here](#) or Locally at I:\projects\lisedev\SpecTclTk\SpecTk_DAK\SpecTk_git\SpecTk
- To begin save your current configuration, or load a file other than unknown.spk. (Unknown.spk will throw an error)
- You are now ready to use either function

Alphabetical

- Under the tab menu there will be the alphabetic option
- Once pressed SpecTk will load and then the change will be seen and saved



Manual Reorder

- Under the tab menu there will be the reorder option
- A window will appear with the name of each tab and its corresponding position.
- Once everything is correctly ordered (no missing or duplicate indices) the reorder button can be pressed
- The desired order will be saved and loaded
- It isn't recommended, but the tab order can be edited directly in the save file.
- To do so go to the second line and change the list as desired (don't add or remove item this will cause an error)
- Once done save the file and open it in SpecTk you will notice that the change isn't present. You will now need to save the configuration and open it once more. Now the desired order will be seen.

General Info

Compatibility

- All .spk files are backwards and forwards compatible
- If an order is set in v1.3.3 it will work in all previous versions, but once a new save is made the order will revert to the pre v1.3.3 order.

Errors

- If an error occurred and it isn't the following:
 - Reorder matching indices
 - Couldn't open Unkown.spk
- Then open an older version of SpecTk load and then save the config, and it should go back to work in both versions.
- It is important to note that this error is only caused if the save file has been manually edited.

Further Comments

- Reordering tabs will save and load the configuration.
- This can sometimes take a while. **!!!Don't!!!** close SpecTk while it reorders things.
- Currently a scroll bar for the reorder window is in the works, but not top priority.
